Website Privacy Policy

1. Thank you for visiting standrewpcusa.org (the Website) and reviewing our Privacy Policy. Your privacy is important to us, and our policy is simple: Except as discussed below, we will not knowingly collect any personally identifiable information about you when you visit the Standrewpcusa.org website unless you choose to provide that information. **This Privacy Policy does not describe nor include information collection practices of other sites, including those linked to or from the Website.**
2. Any information that you voluntarily provide equates to information that you are giving us the consent to use.
3. Personal information may be collected through various means including but not limited to visiting Standrewpcusa.org, through the use of cookies, making a donation to St. Andrew Presbyterian Church, applying to work with/at St. Andrew Presbyterian Church, contacting staff members using email or any other means, through third party-cookies, anonymous data collection and use, or through other means supported by the software used to develop and maintain the Website.
4. To ensure that our website delivers a high-quality experience, we may use your IP address to help diagnose problems on our end and to manage the Standrewpcusa.org website by identifying which areas of the Website are being used the most, as well as to fine-tune our content for users' interest. Your IP address is the number assigned to computers connected to the Internet. This is essentially "traffic data" which cannot personally identify you, but that may be helpful to us for marketing purposes and for improving our services. Traffic data collection only follows your activities as you are using this website, it does not follow your activities on any other websites in any way.
5. Anonymous traffic data may also be shared with business partners and advertisers.
6. Data may also be collected through the use of "cookies". We may utilize the "cookies" feature of major browsers. You may choose to disable cookies through your own web browser's settings, however, disabling this function may diminish your experience on the Standrewpcusa.org website and some features may not work as intended. Other data collection technologies may include, in addition to our own cookies, the use of various third-party cookies, for example, but not limited to, Google Analytics, Google Ads, Google Tag Manager, Facebook Ads Manager, Facebook Pixel, etc.
7. By using the Standrewpcusa.org website, you are agreeing to our Privacy Policy, and further you agree to the use of cookies and similar technologies (for example, web beacons, pixels, tags, and device identifiers which we may collectively refer to as "cookies") as described in this policy.
8. Information that we collect may be used to contact you for follow-up purposes, for promotional purposes, for troubleshooting purposes, and informational updates. It may be used to help process payments online. Your personal information may be needed to process the payments that you could potentially be making to St. Andrew Presbyterian Church. It may be used during targeted social media or search engine

advertisements, and this could be used if the church uses social media services such as Facebook®, for targeted promotional purposes.

9. Whenever you voluntarily provide personal information through the use of standrewpcusa.org, you have consented to that information and its content being seen, collected, and/or otherwise used by others. We cannot be responsible for any unauthorized or improper use of the information that you voluntarily share (i.e., sharing a comment on a blog post, posting in a Facebook group that we manage, sharing details on a group coaching call, etc.).
10. Personal information obtained by standrewpcusa.org is stored internally or through a data management system. We value your safety, so your personal information will only be accessed by people who are responsible for gathering, managing, or storing such information, or who have a legitimate need to access such information. This may include our hosting provider, newsletter provider, payment processors or team members, etc.
11. It is important to note that we may transfer information internationally. If you are using our website in the European Union, please understand that your personal information may be transferred outside of the European Union. By using our the standrewpcusa.org website and providing us with your personal information, you are consenting to these transfers exactly as stated within this Privacy Policy.
12. You have the right to:
 - a. Request information regarding how your information is used and request a copy of what information we use.
 - b. Restrict processing if you think the information is inaccurate, unlawful, or no longer necessary.
 - c. Be “forgotten” from our systems, meaning we will erase your personal information from our databases. (You have the right to be “forgotten”).
 - d. Change your preference regarding whether you consent to our use of your information.
 - e. Lodge a complaint if you feel that any of your information has been unlawfully used.
 - f. Receive personal data portability and transference to another controller without our hindrance.
 - g. Object to our use of your information.
 - h. Not be subject to an automated decision based solely on automatic processing, including profiling, which legally or significantly affects you.
13. **Children's Issues (issues relating to use of website by minors).**

The Website is not directed to children under thirteen (13) years of age, and children under such age must not use the Website or services offered on it to submit any individually identifiable information about themselves. No child under the age of eighteen (18) should ever send email to, or submit any individually identifiable information about themselves to any entity, business, or individual who either advertises or posts a listing on this website without the express approval of their parent or legal guardian. St. Andrew Presbyterian Church shall not be liable to

review or otherwise screen listings, advertisement, or other website information to confirm that they are in compliance with this issue regarding minor children.

14. This Privacy Policy constitutes a contract made under and shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California.
