**Mother Hubbard's Cupboard had a very busy March. We served 2392 individuals (664 families) 821 of those individuals were children.**

**We also went through a lot of food! In January, February and March we distributed over 60,000 pounds of food, including meat, produce, bread items and canned and packaged food items. We strive to continue to feed nutritious food to our food insecure families in the Yuba Sutter area.**

**We will continue to use Room A as a "cooling room" for folks but all our food will be distributed by our back-room volunteers in Mother Hubbard's Cupboard to ensure that food will be distributed fairly to as many people as possible. We are stretching how much food we give per family because of recent cuts of food to the Yuba-Sutter Food Bank.**

**Thank you, St. Andrew congregation and friends, for donating food and funds as we continue our mission at Mother Hubbard's Cupboard to feed the food insecure in our community.**

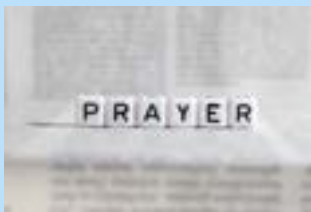
